



Shalom Aleichem

(May Peace Be With You)

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Form:

1. Sing melody in unison.
2. Add low part.
3. Sing all 3 parts together.
4. Repeat all parts, pause at * then ritard.

Note: pronounce ch as in Bach, not hard K like bok; more "throaty"
v=ve as in vest. v'ad="veh-ad"
